PURPOSE

The International Merchant Marine Registry of Belize (IMMARBE) for the purposes of this Merchant Marine Notice reminds all interested parties that:

1. All passenger ships, including high-speed passenger crafts, cargo ships, including high-speed craft of 300 gross tonnage and upward and mobile offshore drilling units shall be fitted with a Long-range identification and tracking of ships (LRIT).

2. All ships of 300 gross tonnage and upwards engaged on international voyages and cargo ships of 500 gross tonnage and upwards not engaged on international voyages and passenger ships irrespective of size shall be fitted with an automatic identification system (AIS).

This Administration would like to encourage all Shipowners, Operators, Deputy Registrars and Recognized Organizations to take note of the contents of this Notice and to ensure its provisions are enforced on board vessels registered at IMMARBE.
